FACILITIES

After a few years in Dietikon, we decided to move the training camp to Au's sports center in Glattbrugg. The football field was in excellent condition, and we were able to do all our training on the natural grass-pitch.

We have two dressing rooms for the players and two for the staff. Therefore it is relevant to quote that the communication between players and staff was very efficient.

Also, the Physios were able to work in a separate room, next to the players' dressing room.

The free parking for their cars is also a plus of training in Glattbrugg.

In addition, the training ground is located close to our office. Therefore, we can meet the players there directly after the training sessions and support and advise them one-to-one in all matters.



MEALS

The sports complex has a restaurant with an indoor area and a large outdoor area.

For the organization was great for us because of the Corona situation; we could eat outside most of the time when the weather was good. Since we could not agree with the restaurant, we organized a catering that directly brought us excellent sports nutrition to the facility.

Furthermore, since everything is close together, the players could do therapy with the physios after training and lunch.





ARCUS PHYSIO

To have a physiotherapist before and after the training sessions and on match days to look after our players is one thing we were very pleased with the situation.

Arcus Physio is only a 5-minute walk from the sports facility and offers top facilities that the players can use.

Besides a large gym, there are also football-specific training facilities indoors. For the regeneration, the players could use the sauna and the Turkish bath.

So the conditions were excellent, and players could take advantage and use it every day without limitation.

And last but not least, we were able to use the modern testing facilities to see where the players currently stand to make them as fit as possible. But also to be able to introduce himself to a new club. So statistics about their current status are essential for clubs.

FRIENDLY MATCHES

This year we could organize four friendly matches against GC u21 (1. League), FC Vaduz (Challenge League), FC Schaffhausen (Challenge League), and AC Bellinzona (Promotion League).

These games serve to allow the players to achieve football fitness, present themselves to the club and scouts, and, most importantly, find a new club as soon as possible.

There were four exciting and well-played test matches against four different opponents.

This year we could also hear that the interest from the clubs to play against our SAFP team increased. It gives us confidence that the collaboration with the clubs will enhance our chance to play even more friendly games on future Training Camps.

The staff team had an outstanding work ethic and cooperated in a great work environment.



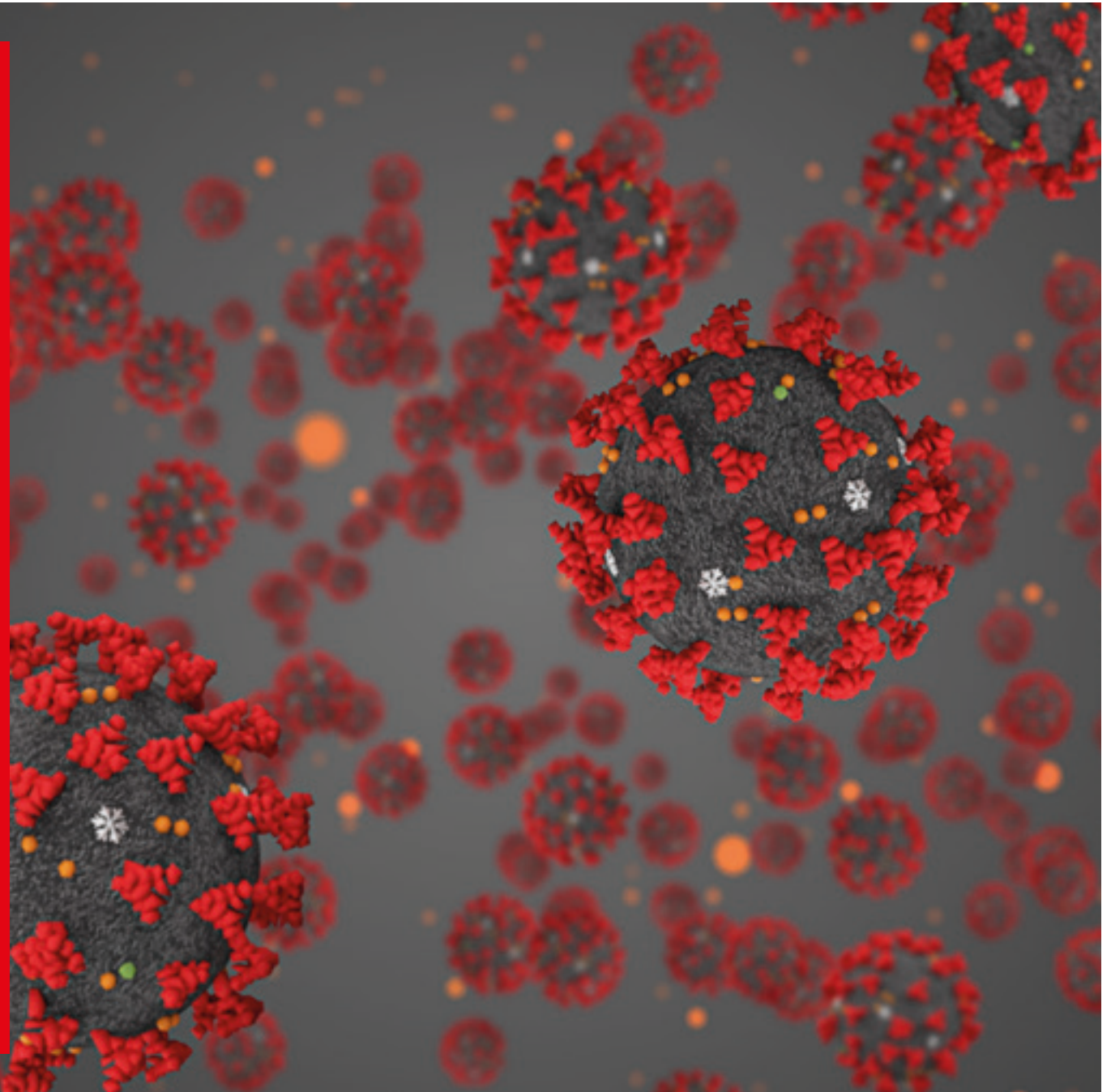
RULES & BEHAVIORS COVID-19
